GENERAL POLICIES AND RELEASES**



Admissions

Rock It Learning accepts students, ages 9-14, based on their talents and abilities and does not discriminate on the basis of sex, race, nationality, ethnic origin, or other irrelevant criteria.

Tuition, Payments, and Refunds

Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis. Students must pay a \$50 nonrefundable deposit to hold their place. The balance is due two weeks prior to the first day of camp. If payment in full is not made by this date, camper enrollment may be subject to cancellation at the discretion of the camp director.

Discounts

Multiple class and sibling discounts are available for any five day camp.

Cancellation of a Camp

In the unlikely event that a camp is cancelled, parents will receive notice within ten days of the scheduled start date. All fees paid will be refunded in full.

Photo Release

Rock It Learning may take photographs or video of any child participating in camp activities, and may use these images for marketing purposes. No compensation will be made for the use of these images. A camper may be identified by first name only.

Travel and Activity Release

I give my child permission to participate in all activities scheduled by Rock It Learning, LLC. I acknowledge that many of the activities will require vehicle transportation. I give Rock It Learning, LLC permission to transport my child to Rock It Learning camp activities. I acknowledge that I have read and agree to all to the provisions contained in the Liability Release Acknowledgement.

Lunch and Snacks: Movies/Videos

Students should bring lunch and snack. G or PG movies may be shown during the lunch break. Your signature below verifies that you permit your child to watch these movies. For a list of possible movies, please contact Rock It Learning.

Conduct and Discipline

Students are expected to conduct themselves in an orderly manner and to treat those working around them with respect. Students whose behavior is disruptive will be removed from the camp, and their parents will be notified. The directors reserve the right, at their sole discretion, to withdraw any camper whose influence or actions are deemed unsatisfactory or detrimental to the camp or who will not abide by the camp rules and policies. If this occurs, no reduction or return of fee, or any part thereof, will be made.

Drop-off and Pick-up

You will be notified of the drop-off and pick-up procedures one week prior to your camp. It is essential that a parent or other authorized adult pick up students when camp is over. Parents who fail to pick up their children within fifteen minutes of the end of their individual session are considered late and will be charged a fee unless a previous arrangement has been made with the staff. In case of emergencies or other situations over which parents have little control, parents should try to telephone Rock It Learning in order to alert the staff. Extended day care (Before-Camp or After-Camp) is available during our summer sessions - see our webpage for further details. When filling out the course selection area, be sure to indicate whether you need to purchase Before-Camp or After-Camp care.

***For the safety of their children, parents must advise them to wait inside the Rock It Learning building to be picked up. Parents or an authorized adult must then come in to get their children.

First Aid and Medications

It is the responsibility of parents to provide Rock It Learning with emergency phone numbers and instructions. Staff are not allowed to administer first aid or to dispense over-the-counter medications to any student without express prior written permission of parents. A first aid kit is available for any student requiring an antiseptic or Band-Aid.
